

SCREENING CRITERIA FOR MOTOR VEHICLE RECORD & BACKGROUND CHECK

WHAT WE CHECK FOR

The motor vehicle report pulls directly from the state DMV or BMV (Department or Bureau of Motor Vehicles). This allows us to check the license header information (license status, issue date, expiration date, etc.). It also allows us to check the 3-year driving history. The driving history section is where we see any accidents, violations and administrative actions.

The criminal background check conducts a felony and misdemeanor search in all counties of residence for the last 7 years. We also check for federal criminal records in the corresponding federal districts where you have lived for the last 7 years. As a supplement to those, we run a nationwide criminal database search which checks all 50 states' sex offender registries as well as a repository of felony and misdemeanor records from county courts throughout the country. These help us locate criminal records in counties that are not included as part of a person's address history. We report any convictions or pending cases we find within the last 7 years, with the exception of minor traffic convictions (for example, speeding or failure to stop) or infractions/citations (for example, dog off lease or noise ordinance violations) unless they involve alcohol, drugs, or violence.
